Historical Context: Why is it on the Agenda?	The committee discussed the Grapevine budget report and referenced the request for funding of services provided by the Grapevine. They felt the decision to fund services for Grapevine should be sent to Conference for further discussion. The financial statements for the first nine months of 2023 contain a new line item under circulation for the apps. These publishing services to the Fellowship are currently at no charge. The Conference Committee on Grapevine will be discussing how these services shall be funded going forward. The 2023 costs include vendor, talent, editing, freelance and platform fees. This agenda item originally was proposed by the A.A fellowship of Area 40, Montana by a group within District 41 that recognized a need in their community after the group was asked to provide literature for the local homeless shelter. To the group's surprise, A.A did not have any pamphlets addressing the homeless, unhoused alcoholic. This pamphlet would be reaching out the hand of A.A to an underserved remote community and allow an unhoused/homeless person to see themselves as a member of A.A and to know they are welcome. The proposed pamphlet would be used in both inward (for the alcoholic) and outward (for non-
