


# Conference? Who makes up the conference

This year there are 133 voting members of the General Service Conference acting together as guardians of A.A.'s World Services and of the Steps and Traditions. They are composed as follows:

What Happens to the Agenda Items at the General Service Conference? There are 11 primary committees and 2 secondary committees.

Delegates are randomly assigned to a primary committee and some delegates are also assigned to a secondary committee.

Each Conference committees discusses their agenda items.

The Conference committees either decide to recommend an agenda item, issue an additional committee consideration or take no action.

If committee decides to take no action, it is the end of the road for the agenda item.

# How Agenda Items Become Advisory Actions

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

Each Committee presents its recommendations

FLOOR ACTION

During the general sessions, members may make recommendations directly from the floor VOTE BY THE FULL CONFERENCE

Passes with substantial unanimity

Fails with less than 2/3 majority

ADVISORY ACTION

When a recommendation is approved it becomes an Advisory Action





# Big Book (English 4<sup>th</sup> Edition)

- Implementation on the new jacket-less format for future printings of the Big Book, Alcoholics Anonymous.
- This jacket-less formatting will help reduce backorders as well as delivery times.
- The first printing of the new cover format English-language Big Book, Alcoholics Anonymous, is scheduled to start printing in mid-October, to be completed November/December 2022.




